A outdoor light can be turned on then off by using a **MOTION** detector.

**GLARE** is one form of Light Pollution and can blind you when you are walking.

**TUCSON** and Pima County have good Outdoor Lighting Codes to keep Bad lights from being used.

Southern **ARIZONA** has more astronomers and telescopes than anywhere in the world.

The night needs to be Dark, not like **DAY** time.
