



Directions to assemble the “Light Pollution Catcher”

1. Cut out square above on the outside lines.
2. Place square on flat surface with writing down & fold each corner to the center.
3. Turn over and fold each corner again to the center and crease all folds.
4. Fold square in half to make a rectangle (not triangle) & crease fold line.
5. Fold square in half the other way to make a rectangle, crease fold line, open up last 2 folds.
6. Place 3 fingers & thumb under “Light Pollution Is Bad” flaps making 4 cones, close sides together.



To Play game (two people required)

1. First person holds the Light catcher and asks the other person to pick a number from 1 to 8.
2. Open the Light Catcher to show the number guessed. Ask the person to guess what the picture by the number has to do with Light Pollution. Open picture flap to read answer.
3. Ask person to pick another number. Repeat step 2 above.
